For Improvement of IL Route 9 in Bloomington

The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced today a public meeting has been scheduled for April 2, 2019, from 4:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. at Bloomington High School, 1202 East Locust Street, Bloomington, IL, for the purpose of discussing the improvement of IL Rte. 9 from the intersection of Market Street and Martin Luther King Dr. east to the intersection of East Empire Street and Carnahan Drive. All persons interested in this project are invited to attend the meeting.

The meeting will be conducted on an informal basis with project displays and other information available for viewing. IDOT representatives will also be available to explain the project, answer individual questions and record comments offered by those in attendance. Particularly, comments regarding bicycle and pedestrian accommodations, parking impacts, and from potentially affected property owners, are encouraged.

Preliminary reports, including an engineering analysis with drawings, maps, and aerial photography, will be available for inspection and viewing during the entire time the IDOT representatives are present.
